Representative Payee Services will manage benefits by paying living expenses from a month's budget with the benefits social security (SS), supplemental security (SSI), or social security disability (SSDI) income.

Organizational Representative Responsibilities

As your Representative Payee The Arc Kent County will make an application to the Social Security Administration to be the responsible party to manage your SSI, SSDI or Social Security income and pay your bills through a mutually agreed upon budget.

The Arc Kent County Rep Payee Best Practice

The Arc Kent County will treat all individuals served with dignity and respect and when able will provide education on money management, support alternatives to expensive purchases and affordable and safe housing options. Often times we see exploitation of these funds and a trusted professional representative payee can reduce this and also help maintain or increase independence, eliminate the struggle with families/guardians managing such funds and increase financial stability for the beneficiary.
